PUBLIC MEMBERS SELECTION MEETING

METHOD OF ELECTION

1. Nominees

A person is entitled to stand for election to, to be elected as, to be a member of the Carraig Gheal Wind Farm Community Benefit Fund Steering Group provided that person –

- has achieved 16 years of age on the day of election
- is resident within the community council area the election is held in

2. Electors

A person is entitled to vote in an election of community councillors provided that person –

- has achieved 16 years of age on the day of election
- is resident within the community council area the election is held in

3. Election protocol

Should the number of public candidates validly nominated exceed the total number of seats in the community council area, a poll will be held. At the poll, each elector will be entitled to vote for one candidate.

In any poll for the election of public candidates those candidates who receive the highest number of votes cast will be elected.

The Returning Officer shall retain the ballot box and shall count the ballot papers therein.

The Returning Officer shall announce the results of the election within 24 hours.

4. Returning Officer

The Returning Officer shall be the Carraig Gheal Wind Farm Community Fund Officer.
